2011 Donations

- \$1980 Sponsoring 5 children through World Vision
- \$20,000.00 UNIVERSAL YOUTH FOUNDATION -- Committed to provide educational assistance to children and youth in Canada and throughout the world by funding schools and teachers thereby inspiring a new generation of leaders.
- \$727,443.00 Generated through a Fundraising campaign Canada wide to provide needed equipment for a Hospital in Aquila severely damaged by the Abruzzo earthquake.

SOCIAL ACTIVITIES

- \$8148.00 Raised through a Charity Golf Tournament organized by the Priory of Central Canada to be allocated to sponsor the Annual Christmas Dinner at the Good Shepherd Centre in Toronto in December 2011 for approximately 800 homeless recipients.
- “GIFTS OF A KIND” Annual campaign for donations from various members of the Grand Priory to be distributed to residents of Senior Homes to brighten occasions like Christmas, Easter etc..by Members of the Grand Priory.

2012 Donations

- \$1000.00 To Ronald McDonald Home - Established in 1981 as a Registered Canadian Charity and considered the “Home of Hope” in Toronto. It provides a” home away from home” for seriously ill children and their families to heal better together.

SOCIAL ACTIVITIES

- \$25,000.00 A major Social activity organized by the Priory of Eastern Canada to benefit the “Confrerie Kuan - Ti - a non Profit Organization. The Brotherhood Kuan-Ti’s mission is to mainly help poor young people, dropouts and/or living in low socio-economical status in Quebec by introducing them to Chinese martial arts on a non-competitive basis.

The Annual Golf Tournament organized by the Priory of Central Canada is to be held on October 5th. hoping to raise \$10,000.00 to sponsor mainly the annual Christmas Dinner for the homeless and underprivileged in Toronto. This project has become very popular with the recipients that visit annually for it at the good Shepherd Centre. Many of our Knights, Dames and Ladies from the Grand Priory volunteer to distribute the food prepared for them.

As a continuing practice of our Grand Priory, small cash donations and “Gifts of a kind” are presented continually during the year to other Registered Charities in Canada. Not to be forgotten are the volunteers in our ranks that visit Hospitals, the shut-ins and bereaved families.
